ACCOMODATION

Make bookings as early as possible due to rooms being hard to come by from July through August. Please note that some lodgings will be unavailable from October to April or May.

Vegans please advise your host well in advance since veganism is very uncommon in this part of France.

If you intend to look for accommodation by yourself, please bear in mind that you will be driving on mountain roads with many twists and turns - what may look like a small distance on a map may amount to a significant trip. Aim to stay on Causse Méjean or you will have to allow for at least half an hour's drive to the centre.

Breakfast, dinner and/or a packed lunch may be included - ask your host.
